Memory Text: “How can a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed according to Your word. With my whole heart I have sought You; oh, let me not wander from Your commandments! Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You” ([Psalm 119:9-11, NKJV](#)).

Thoughts to Ponder: Your habits reveal purpose and direction in your life. Stewards who develop good habits are the most faithful stewards. Daniel had a habit of daily prayer ([Dan. 6:10](#)). Paul’s custom was to be in the synagogue ([Acts 17:1, 2](#)). He also writes: “Do not be deceived: ‘Evil company corrupts good habits’” ([1 Cor. 15:33, NKJV](#)). We are to cultivate good habits in order to replace bad ones. The pathway that a habit creates is the fastest way that you can take to get the reward you seek. A habit is an ingrained decision. In other words, you don’t even have to think about it; you just do it. That habit can be very good or very bad, depending upon what it is you do. This week we looked at powerful habits that will help a steward conduct God’s business.
